Course Overview

This one-day training course is designed for personnel working in and around marinas in coastal / tidal locations, whose role takes them within 3-metres of the water's edge or aboard a vessel, and who may be faced with dealing with accidental immersion of their colleagues, clients, third parties or themselves.



Who Should Attend?

Any member of staff who has a waterside role, who will operate within 3-metres of the water's edge or aboard a vessel and allow them to operate safely near water, and to carry out co-worker rescue with a grounded knowledge of the hazards and risks of the environment along with the skills to deal with matters arising.

- Gain essential water safety knowledge tailored to marina environments.
- Learn practical rescue skills to respond to water-related emergencies.
- Improve confidence in managing safety risks around the marina or harbour.
- Enhance compliance with health & safety obligations for staff working near water.

- Decision-Making Under Pressure – How to act decisively and effectively in real-life water emergencies.
- Legal Responsibilities & Best Practices – Ensuring compliance with safety regulations.
